NEW KEY FOB SYSTEM

The Board will review the revised contract for the finalization of the new key fob system at the meeting on August 28. If approved, the key fob system will be up and running within 30 days.

Owners who have NOT received their new FOB key, PLEASE CONTACT SARA TAYLOR as soon as possible to make arrangements to get it!!! The old key system and keys will be obsolete within 30 days of the new key fob system being in place. There will be a dual key system during this change-over for a short period of time, but at some point the old key system will not be available. Common area cards will still be used in the drive-in garage entry and the clubhouse.

What is a FOB? Pronounced like Bob A keyless entry device that will replace the lobby and pedestrian garage keys.

THE MARINA CLUB AT CHANNEL ISLANDS

Residents and their quests enjoy use of the beautiful waterside clubhouse, pool, spa and gym facilities, gas barbeques, extensive free parking and two tennis courts. These amenities are called The Marina Club at Channel Islands and membership is exclusive to the Channel Islands Waterfront Homes residents and the Anacapa Isle Marina tenants who rent boat slips here. Cost of maintenance and management are shared between the HOA and the Marina which helps keep our HOA costs down. Inside the Marina Clubhouse are the offices for the Marina and our HOA staff. Anacapa Isle Marina manages the clubhouse. Reservations for the private meeting room are arranged through the marina. All questions regarding clubhouse use should be directed to them at (805) 985-6035 or by sending Sara an email which she will forward to them. "Members" use their common area pass card to enter the clubhouse facilities which are open daily from 8:30 a.m. - 10 p.m.

No one notices suspicious activity better than you!


Our panoramic views offer a bird's-eye-view of our beautiful surroundings and the bustle of activity in and
